12 RESOLVED, ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ΟF THE 13 NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we 14 designate April 30, 2015 and April 28, 2016 as Envirothon Day 15 throughout Illinois to bring recognition to the activities of 16 the Envirothon program.
