WHEREAS, Illinois is an active participant in the International Envirothon Competition; and

WHEREAS, Envirothon participants gain valuable knowledge and training in ecology and natural resource management

12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL
13 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate April 30,
14 2015 and April 28, 2016 as Envirothon Day throughout Illinois
15 to bring recognition to the activities of the Envirothon
16 program.
