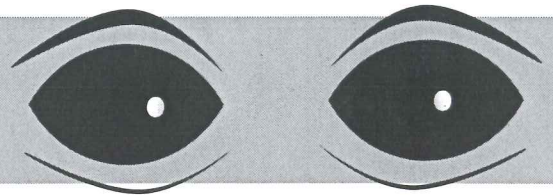

Talking Points . . .

- * SWCDs provide State source **cost share incentives** to farmers and urban landowners for construction of **conservation best management practices (BMPs)**
- * **Conservation practices** account for an estimated **reduction of 85-90 thousand tons of soil erosion** and accompanying **pollutants to surface waters**
- * **NOT FUNDING SWCDs**, an estimated **85 to 90 thousand tons of soil will erode** into ditches, streams, rivers and lakes and with it will be an estimated **170 - 180 thousand pounds of Nitrogen** and **85 - 90 thousand pounds of Phosphorous** will enter **Illinois waterways every year!**
- * SWCDs help **promote, educate** and **implement federal Farm Bill programs**
- * **SWCDs** are the **ONLY** unit of government in Illinois that has **NO TAXING AUTHORITY**
- * **SWCDs** are the **first line of defense** for **helping landowners manage their nutrients** by developing a plan to reduce contributions to Illinois waterways and ultimately the Gulf of Mexico
- * **SWCD programs** are capable of **adding more than \$300+ million** to the **State's economy EVERY YEAR!**
- * **SWCD funding** has **decreased nearly 70% since 2008!**

Legislation We are **WATCHING**



Filter Strip Tax Law—SB2160

Amends the Property Tax Code. Provides that a Section concerning the valuation of vegetative filter strips is repealed on December 31, 2026 (instead of December 31, 2016).

FY 17 Budget—SWCD in at \$4 million

(\$2 million Operations & \$2 million Cost-Share)

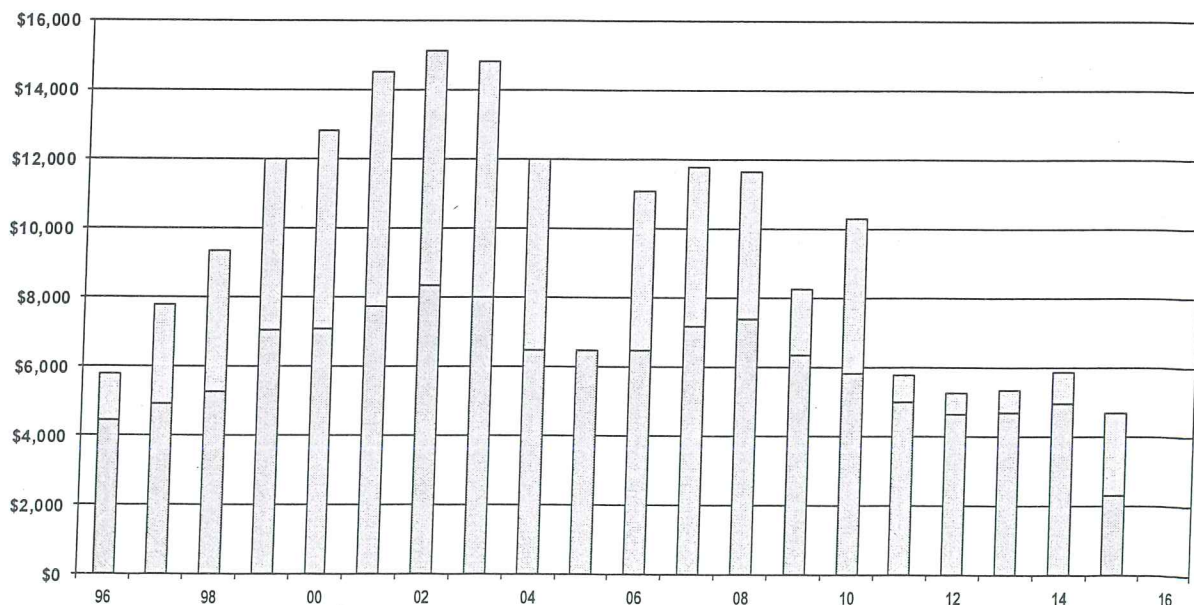

in millions

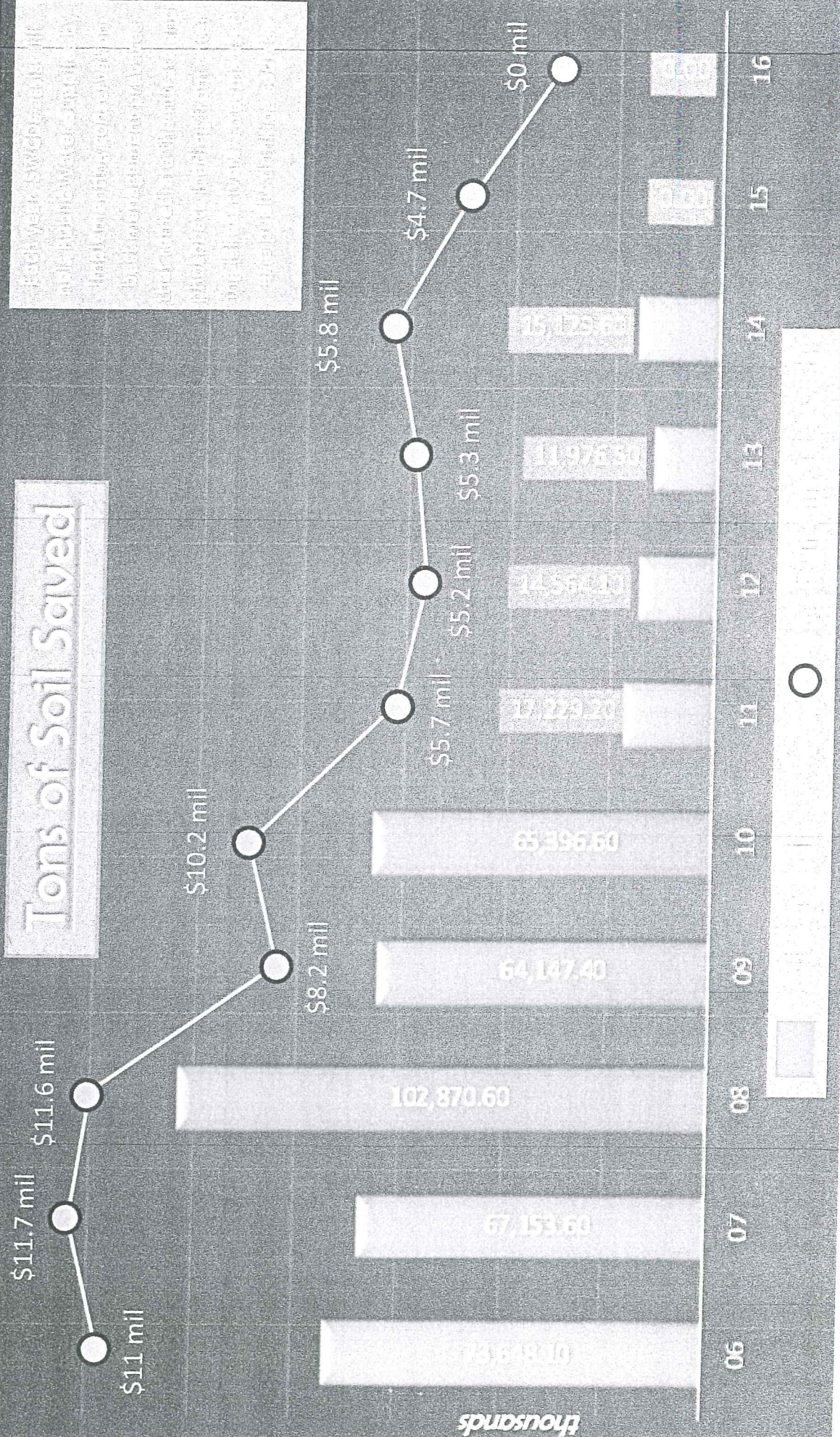
Fiscal Year

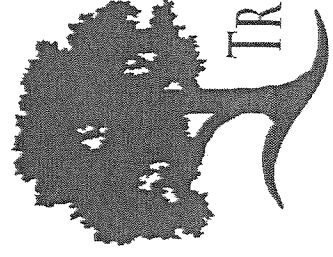
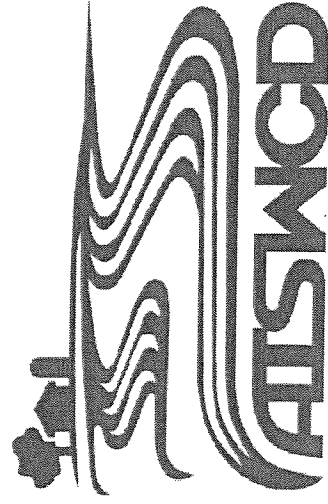
