Practice based evaluation system on individual fields

- Science based Field Form is locally developed and straight forward
- **STAR Ranking system easy to understand**

#### S.T.A.R. REWARDS - Pilot Incentive Program

 Incentive to Illinois farmers willing to implement new practices that increase their STAR Rating









- Improvements from crop year 2019-2020 and 2020-2021
- Funds to be allocated March 2021
- Cap of 200 acres or \$2,000 per farmer
- Farmers who participated in S.T.A.R. in 2019 given priority

### S.T.A.R. REWARDS - Application Process

- ID interested farmer and fields with 2019 or 2020 STAR Rating
- ID new practices farmers might try in 2021
- Check STAR Scoresheet to verify practices generate points to increase STAR rating
- Notify STAR Coordinator of willing participants
- Once approved, secure agreement that identifies practices that will achieve an improved rating
  - Agreements between AFT and Farmer Feb 2021
  - Allocate funds by March 2021





### S.T.A.R. REWARDS - Application Process

#### S.T.A.R. Coordinators can help!

- Can provide list of 2019 and 2020 participants in your county
- Can work with you and the farmer on identifying practices and the points needed to improve STAR rating
- Will let you know if a farmer's application is considered and help establish agreements
